Looking for NEW Victoria Church Treasurer ☺

"Victoria Church SDA Church is currently looking for a church treasurer. BC Conference & our local Victoria SDA finance committee will provide all the necessary training required for this important ministry.

- **Some background in accounting & bookkeeping would be appreciated, but not necessary.** Because of time commitment (around 6 hours/week) needed for this ministry, the church provides a small monthly stipend.

- **Job Description:** "The church treasurer receives, counts, receipts, disburses, keeps account of and reports on all money that comes into the church in a timely manner. Tithes and offerings are sent to the conference monthly along with a financial report. Money given for the local church, money from the different entities within the church and any other finances handled by the local congregation are distributed as directed by the church budget or by the board or business meeting action. This includes the payment of accounts, insurance premiums, utilities, rents, departmental expenses purchased on behalf of the church and payment for services and maintenance. The treasurer will be called on to file a financial report at each board and business meeting indicating what money has been received and how it has been expended as well as the financial position (bank and fund balances). The position of treasurer is an office that serves on the church board, is a member on the church ministries council, and on the Finance Committee.
